
2. What is innovation?

- Idea /put into practice / with success
- You don't know this in advance
- Combine targeted mix of actors, <u>such as</u>
- Interactive innovation model, beyond linear innovation
- Why is interactive innovation so useful (bottomup, cross-fertilisation, use of tacit knowledge, solutions adapted to circumstances, making use of farmers' peer to peer, integration in day-to-day advice etc)
- Legal base




3. EIP-AGRI Operational Groups – basic principles


- Who (such as...), not <u>always</u> researchers needed
- Must tackle practical needs of farmers/foresters, it is not to Man. Auth. to decide on beforehand who
- Various types of activities (development of new products, pilot projects, but <u>also</u> short supply chain, environmental projects, climate change etc)
- New group, or existing group with new project
- Flexible, lean and open system needed, bottomup, no need for high number of partners
- Generating knowledge freely available to all
- Very different from LAGs



4. Innovation support services, including advisors focusing on innovation

- Experience learns you need supporting environment
- Various types of help (well connected to agric. world):
 - Help to start up a specific group = prepare the project (innovation broker)
 - 2. Help to facilitate the project (facilitator, intermediate)
 - **3.** Innovation support service (covering all this and more)
- Role of the NRNs (OG partner search, networking)

New roles for farm advisors

5. EIP AGRI networking

- EIP AGRI network at EU level, facilitated by SP
- Connecting and supporting "EU wide" EIP network (= all actors, stakeholders, networks in MS/regions)
- Networking activities of EIP-AGRI network (FGs, Wksh, Seminar, etc)
- Interaction with national and regional levels (NRNs, EIP networks)
- EIP AGRI website, one-stop-shop for innovation in EU agriculture and forestry
- Details on FGs, NRN tasks, utility of existing networks, possibility to create new networks
