Inspiration

- 1. Sustainable intensification system – e.g. precision farming 'doing more with less'**
- 2. Agricultural diversification – e.g. ecosystem services**
- 3. Where to collect and share information**
- 4. Benchmarking between farmers (EU / national)**
- 5. peer-to-peer exchange (national level) - Erasmus for farmers (EU level)**
- 6. EU networking to support independent advisory services**
- 7. Adequate communication tools including low barrier tools – e.g. text messages**
- 8. How to better connect practice, research and advisory services – e.g. language barriers (between actors and between countries) and incentives**
- 9. Use of waste, logistics , storage, biosecurity**
- 10. Integration of the value chain: mapping challenges and opportunities**
- 11. Food waste**
- 12. Climate change adaptation: Water management, use genetic resources, crops diversity, sanitary solutions, agro-forestry**
- 13. Climate change mitigation: Carbon sequestration, emission reduction in livestock sector, fertilisation techniques, waste management (biogas)**
- 14. Improve contracting power of farmers (logistics, tools,...)**
- 15. Education needs from farmers on market innovation**
- 16. Establish structure/body to monitor data on market innovation from regional level**
