


Timing Programme Adoption




State of play in programming on 26/5/2015

RDP adoption status - as of 26 May 2015




EAFRD budget

■ Adopted ■ Not Adopted




MS with adopted RDPs

■ All or some ■ None






State of play in programming on 26/5/2015

Status as of 26 May 2015: 51 programmes adopted









Target for Knowledge Transfer & Innovation (KTI)

Figures show the targets set in the RDPs by Member States and regions




EIP in the 2014 – 2020 RDPs

- Rest to be approved by mid 2015


Number of Operational Groups
