## Which good practices for knowledge exchange activities work well in your country/region?

Some context information: 397 OGs - about 120 million euros (partners: 48,8% of farmers)

259 pilot projects - about 75 million euros

In Italy this approach had a good success!

#### **Good practices**:

- 1. Dedicated networking activities: NRN National Focus about
  - Cereals
  - Viticulture
  - Green chemistry and bioeconomy
  - Zootechnics

**Objective of Focus**: knowledge exchange between different type of actors (farmers, experts, researchers, consultants and civil society)

**Methodology:** focus groups, seminars, territorial meetings, interviews, statistical analysis

### Which good practices for knowledge exchange activities work well in your country/region?

#### 2. INNOVARURALE website:

- Content: repository of information about AKIS (documents, OGs DataBase, training)
- Possibility to sign up and receive news about selected topics
- Possibility to share innovations and search for partners
- 3. Rur@Lab: tool for extensionists and consultants to design and manage teaching materials to be used in vocational training courses (not an e-learning platform!)
  - Co-designed and tested with professional farming organizations





### Which challenges for knowledge exchange activities do you see in your country/region?

- 1. Governance: A strong coordination both at <u>regulatory level</u> and <u>implementation level</u> is necessary. It will be essential to promote not just a coordinated strategy using all available tools but also an institutional coordination (e.g. shared and similar procedures, shared criteria of selection). A first attempt is the AKIS national group!
- 2. **Training:** It is necessary training all AKIS actors (not just farmers and extensionists) about methodological tools to work together in the system

### Which knowledge exchange activities would you like to see planned in the CAP AKIS plan of your country/region?

At the moment Italian CAP AKIS plan is <u>in progress</u>. The Ministry of Agricultural Policies and the regions are discussing the context analysis and the SWOT analysis.

In general, some important issues to be planned are:

- Coordination between AKIS instruments
- Coordination between regions (e.g. at interregional level) about some specific production sectors and cross-cutting issues
- Moreover, some regions noticed the importance of a greater use of practical exchange activities (such as on-farm demonstration and farmer-to-farmer exchanges) instead of more traditional training instruments
