
• What are your country's needs?

Network of knowledge exchange (ECOPIONET).

Formed by farmers (pioneers and tutors), advisors, technicians and researchers.

Pioneers will receive training courses on organic farming, commercialization and associationism as well as personalized and continuous advice by technical advisers specially trained for the task.

Technical workshops, demonstration trials in experimental farms, field workshops and meetings between tutors and pioneers.

Under discussion with Spanish Regions

- Actions and events to involve administrations and stakeholders
 - Workshop on AKIS. Madrid, 18th Feb. 2019 to bring together the technical staff of the Spanish Regions (Comunidades Autónomas) that will work on the organizational set-up of AKIS: open discussion forum and collaborative environment
 - National Focus Group on Advisory in AKIS. Madrid, Dec. 2019-July 2020: Analyse and identify the actors that can shape and develop the advisory tasks within AKIS. to achieve efficient institutional support to strengthen knowledge transfer and innovation in the agri-food sector. (33 members. 3 meetings -1 virtual-.COM at 2nd meeting. 5 challenges. Focus on the achievement of CAP objectives)
- ✓ Participation in Horizon 2020 projects on AKIS (FairShare and i2Connect)
- ✓ Advisors participation in OG
- ✓ Advisors training in the National training Plan of MAPA
- ✓ Measure 2 Advisory services in the PDRs

- Which measures for modern and interactive advisory services, integrated within the AKIS, are being planned post 2020 (funded by EU, national, regional or other, or non-funded)?
 - Designing of interventions according to the needs identified:
 - ✓ Advisors integration within the AKIS stablishing the minimum requirements for advisors for registration:
 - ✓ Qualification: possible minimum level vocational training
 - ✓ Continuous training: hours/year
 - ✓ Participation/relation innovation activities/bodies: Horizon Europe projects, OG's projects, universitiesresearch centres...; organization cross visits...
 - ✓ Other skills
 - ✓ Advisor's Platform: DDBB advisors registered, searching engine for farmers, training and exchange of knowledge for advisors, link to innovation activities, monitoring to identify new needs.
 - ✓ Empowering AKIS and Innovation ecosystem: networks within stakeholders and among them i.e. thematic multiactor meetings:
 - ✓ Who: farmers-advisors, advisors-researchers, advisor-researchers-enterprises (inputs, technology)
 - ✓ Objectives: inspirational sessions to build bottom-up innovations; exchange of experiences; to build trust and empathy between two specific groups of stakeholders

 Which measures for modern and interactive advisory services, integrated within the AKIS, are being planned post 2020 (funded by EU, national, regional or other, or non-funded)?

Under discussion with Spanish Regions

- ✓ AKIS governance:
 - ✓ Is going to include the Ministry of Science and Innovation: Higher involvement of research
 - ✓ Use of existing structures and bodies+ reinforce with new bodies for specific aspects
 - ✓ There is going to be a Coordination Unit at National level
- New challenges: Support for the F2F Strategy => specific AKIS actions can help a lot to change farmers' behaviour towards the F2F objectives with training on F2F targets (connectivity, use of inputs)
