What are needs in the field of *Social innovation and inclusiveness?*

- Inclusion of people from disadvantaged or excluded groups in rural areas;
- Stimulating the economic development and innovation in rural areas with the use of social, economic, cultural, environmental and landscape potential as well as digital tools;
- Broader use of flexible forms of work, also with the use of ICT;
- Strengthening the local community implementation of bottom-up initiatives, e.g. conscious buying of local products, supporting entrepreneurial attitudes influencing the development of local communities.

All needs under Specific objective 8

- Which measures for social innovation and inclusiveness are being taken already?
- social innovations and inclusiveness are addressed in RDP 2014-2020 under:
 - starting-up business: eg. taking care for elderly people or small children,
 - LEADER by implementation of local development strategies (LDS). Support for improvement of infrastructure, starting a business or developing it, trainings, local processing incubators. Up to that LDS can be focused on solving specific problems of disadvantaged groups, especially in the labour market, if such a need resulted from the diagnosis of the area.
 - National Rural Network exchange of knowledge and experience: study visits, meetings, networking
- national funds
 - preparation of the strategy for development of care farms (taking care of elderly people or people with special needs on the farm), the model of a caring farm and necessary legislation
 - support for initiatives taken by rural women
 - development of e-services
 - support for rural inhabitants by public advisory services (individual or group advice, trainings, publications, study visits, promotion of local initiatives, esp. in fairs, social media)
- creation of the educational farms' network
- broadband & suport for social cooperatives under Cohesion Policy

- Which measures for social innovation and inclusiveness are being planned post 2020?
- LEADER implementation of the local development strategy,
- start-ups
- active role of the National Rural Network
- introduction to the RDP of a new tool like Smart Village is considered
- creation of a platform for elderly people to help them find neccessary services, is considered
- development of broadband network and e-services
- development of care farms



2) Modern and interactive advisory services post 2020

• What are needs?

- development of modern IT tools / applications for agricultural advisors to conduct effective advisory work at the farm level
- creation of a single digital platform for knowledge exchange, inc. on-line discussion forum for advisors
- appropriate technical devices for public advisors (laptops, mobile phones, internet, devices to measure soil fertility, weather stations, etc.)
- trainings (new challenges, soft skills, technological trainings), career path and specialisation of advisors
- broader use of on farm demonstrations
- closer co-operation between advisors and researchers (thematic networks, on-going co-operation, incentives for researchers)
- increasing the use of multi actor approach in the practice (group advisory, further engagement in support for operational groups, thematic networks at regional and national level)

2) Modern and interactive advisory services post 2020

- Which measures for modern and interactive advisory services, integrated within the AKIS, are being taken already
- creation of the Network of Innovation in Agriculture and a country-wide network of innovation brokers (based on public advisory system);
- involvement of advisors in EPI OG (measure "Cooperation,") suport of creation and participation;
- networking activities (regular meetings between researchers and agricultural advisory services, interships for advisors in experimental farms run by agricultural institutes; thematic meetings & events);
- developing a national network of demonstration farms has started;
- involvement of agricultural advisory services in international projects (Horizon 2020, Interreg, Life + projects);
- preparation of the concept for a digital platform for knowledge exchange has started;
- creation of databases and tools to support advisors' work (examples: eDwin, Agrobank) has started;
- support for post-graduate studies for advisors and other trainings under RDP;
- use of remote learning methods in trainings for advisors as well as for farmers

2) Modern and interactive advisory services post 2020

- Which measures for modern and interactive advisory services, integrated within the AKIS, are being planned post 2020?
- trainings for advisors, e.g. soft skills, technological, forms of distant learning with the use of modern and dedicated IT platforms;
- broader involvement of National Rural Network in supporting activities taken by advisory services, co-operation between actors (thematic networks, on-going co-operation, support for operational groups, thematic networks at regional and national level, incentives for researchers);
- continous implementation of projects in cooperation with scientific institutes;
- development of modern IT tools / applications for agricultural advisors to conduct effective advisory work at the farm level;
- creation of a single digital platform for knowledge exchange, inc. on-line discussion forum for advisors;
- broader use of on farm demonstrations;
- comprehensive advisory services for farmers.
