Why a voucher system?

BE - Flanders



A voucher system is **easy to be managed** once it is setted up.
We believe it is the **most flexible way** to organise
supported knowledge exchange.

Appropriate tool to provide both the farmers and the advisors a **low threshold for participation**.

NL - Netherlands



We have a high level of research, but low uptake.

There is a need to activate private advisors toward helping farmers also to face societal challenges.


HU - Hungary



We would like to **motivate farmers** to go for knowledge exchange services.

It can be a **simple and fast** electronic system, a **,one stop shop'** where they have **free choice** of services with **no prefinancing.**

Scope of the system



,template advice is **limited to be** up-to-date and flexible'

to ensure service is given in **priority topics**, we:

- set requirements at certification process
- **generate demand** by setting knowledge exchange as an obligation as part of other proposals
- support setting up of certain services'




FLANDERS system (current)






FLANDERS system (plans)
