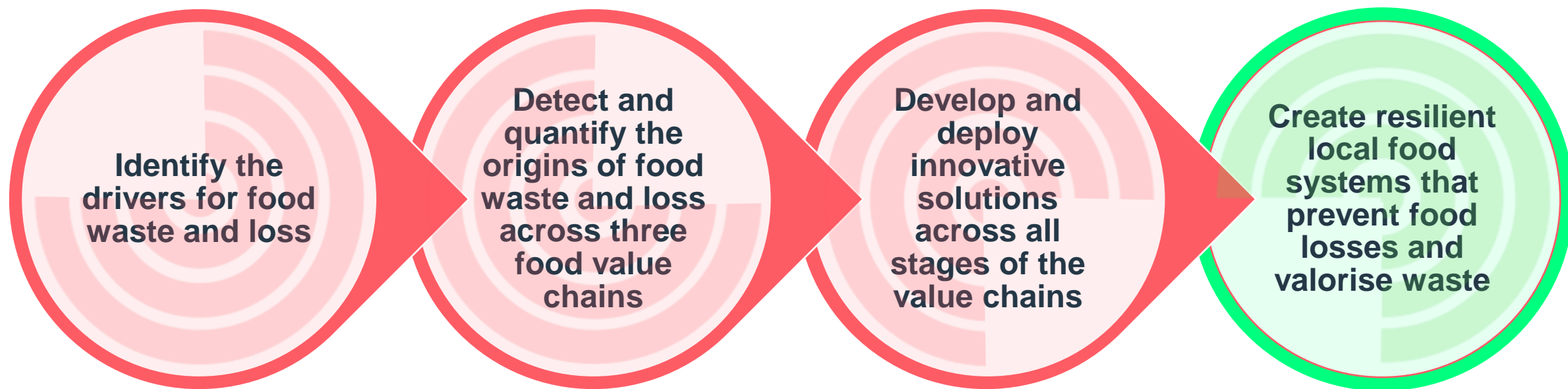

8 European reference regions including coastal, industrial, urban, rural and touristic areas



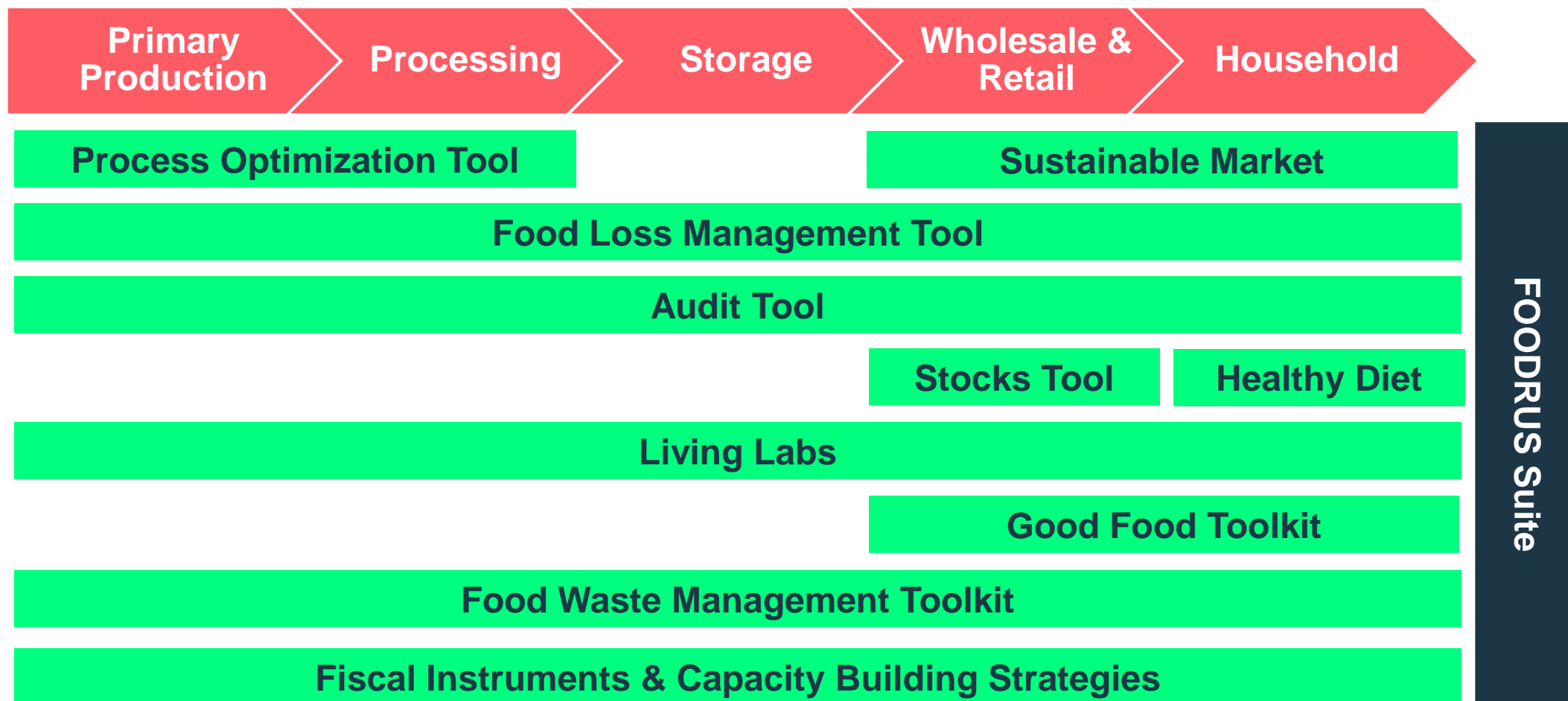
