A) Context & Need

- Is social innovationin your recognized and acknowledged Member State as a real need in agriculture, forestry and rural development?
 - Yes The Netherlands sees the need for social innovation. It will be addressed in the CAP-national strategic plan.
- In your expert opinion, what are the main rural sectors / contexts/areas in which social innovation is needed in your
 Member State?
 - It is needed in all areas, f.i. young farmers, new entrants, risk management, gender, closing the gap between farmers and citizens, transition to sustainable farming, local transitions in areas and organization of foodchains.

A) Context & Need

 - There is a need for smart instruments to support social innovations. How to support social advice, new entrants/next generation, meetings, trust and especially how to reach farmers who need most help.
 - There is little awareness of the importance of change in consumer behaviour, related to dietary choices, healthy living, food waste and local purchasing

B) Existing good practice for fostering social innovation

- Is it possible to identify existing good practices for the fostering of social innovation in your Member State? What are these existing good practices? How are they supported? Who is implementing them?
 - Yes !!, let's share good practices.
 - F.i 'bedrijfsplannen' which is a checklist to support the advice on a farm. With the checklist a farmer gets a better insight of his situation and his/her ambition.
 - (Young) Farmer-citizen activities: Herenboeren, CSA's etc.
 - Supported by 'vouchers' and implemented by advisors

- To what extent have these existing good practices for fostering social innovation been supported to-date by the CAP (notably rural development measures)?
 - Will be supported in the CAP national plans
 - Measure risk management in ths CAP
 - Some good practices have been supported under the current measures
 LEADER and EIP AGRI

C) Strengthening the AKIS for social innovation
