Enhance knowledge flows and strengthen links between research and practice

- In the name of the National Food Strategy, AKIS is mainly strengthened by national funding, with the aim of simplification of CAP
- Some examples. New multi actor centres (4 years, almost 5 million EUR each)
 - Plant-based proteins for health and wellbeing PAN Sweden
 - SustAinimal a collaborative research centre exploring the future role of livestock in sustainable and competitive Swedish food production systems
 - Food Innovation Enabling Sustainable Transition FINEST
- Increased funding for EIP with the requirement of cooperation with researchers, advisors and farmers in OG's. More or less open calls.









Integrate farm advisory services within the AKIS

- Increased budget for training and Multi Actor projects
- Farm advisory services are already integrated in AKIS
- Private advisors mainly in production techniques.
 Publicly funded advisors in environment and climate.
- Few large inpartial private advisory service companies with several fields of competence. Smaller specialised advisory companies.
- Need for more training in e.g. digitalisation and animal housing
- Advisers are often partners in EIP and in MA projects
- Advisory companies and the Board of Agriculture arrange training







Encourage interactive innovation projects

- Increased budget for knowledge exchange, cooperation, EIP-Agri
- Anounced plans for new knowledge centres
- More than 100 EIP-Agri Operational Groups in Sweden
- About 50 million EUR for new EIP-projects 2023-2027 (2% of Pillar 2)
- Support for creating an OG, 12 000 EUR
- Reseachers, advisors and farmers participate in focus groups and networks
- New calls for MA projects







Support digital transition serving effective AKIS

- Sweden No. 3 in EU in Digital Economy and Society Index (DESI).
 Goal no 1. Broadband in world class.
- National investment support for broadband
- Digital methods for advisory service, will make it easier to reach farmers in remote areas and in specialised production, e.g. poultry and horticulture
- Investment support for new technology, incl. digital techniques
- Support for training to modernise, improve, diversify, automatise, digitalise
- Building a digital infrastructure with platforms and database, partly CAP

- Swedish Rural Network enhances and strengthens AKIS cooperation, more pronounced tasks for the CAP-network


