1. Experiences with EIP OGs in 2014-2022

- Content of calls topics like
 - → Agriculture 4.0 interlinking information /data with production-technical processes for the purpose of optimisation and/or efficiency increase
 - → Reduction of emissions in agricultural practice
 - → Increase of the welfare of farm animal
 - → Improving the risk management on farms
 - → Biodiversity and management
 - → Climate-relevant approaches in agriculture
 - → Addressing societal challenges in the context of agriculture
 - → Improving market opportunities along the agricultural value chain
 - → Strengthening the circular economy



1. Experiences with EIP OGs in 2014-2022

Outcomes and Acceptance

- **≠**5 calls
- 2-stage selection procedure
- **■** about 150 applications
- 39 Operational Groups 39 Innovation projects
- 16 projects concerning the establishment of the OG / development of the project plan
- Approved funding amount in total EUR 14.9 million



1. Experiences with EIP OGs in 2014-2022

- Management and Administration: Federal Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry, Regions and Water Management
- Paying Agency: Agrarmarkt Austria
- Support: National network office
- → Many new cooperations and interesting projects
- → great challenges in administration





- How will your calls be different from the current period?
 - Ongoing application (open-topic), calls only in connection with the Bio top-ups
 - 2 phases, decoupled
 - 1st phase: Presentation of the idea and optional application (structure OG)
 - 2nd phase: Innovation project of the Operational Group
 - Funding period max. 4 years
 - Max. EUR 400,000 for both phases
 - Flat rate of EUR 10,000 in phase 1 (min. 2 actors from different fields)



2 interventions for OG

77-6: European Innovation Partnership (EIP-AGRI) - Multi-actor approach in the agricultural sector

77-3: rural innovation ecosystems - Multi-actor approach in the non-farm sector with two strands:

- Building of rural innovation supporting networks (management capacity building)
- Rural innovation partnership: Implementing innovative concepts and projects



Any specific novelties you want to introduce? for instance rural innovation, knowledge network for AKIS actors, biodiversity result-based testing to prepare CAP AECM / (eco) schemes, etc



- 4 fields of action for the further development of the Austrian AKIS:
- knowledge generation and processing: strengthening the knowledge base, increasing practical relevance and target-group-oriented processing
- knowledge transfer: accelerate the transfer and exchange of knowledge in AKIS, especially through education and counselling.
- digitalisation: drive forward the digital transformation of austrian agriculture and forestry and smart villages.
- networking: improve networking and exchange among AKIS act order to use synergies and increase the impact of their activities
