Background

Skills Partnership for the Agri-food Ecosystem

- Knowledge and skills are key to ensure a smart, sustainable and resilient agricultural sector
- Very few farm managers in the EU have full agricultural training, seven out of ten having only practical experience (Eurostat, 2016).
- CAP: resources for knowledge exchange and information remains modest (2% EAFRD); no leverage of learning mobility opportunities (ERASMUS+)

Strategic: developing and retaining skills and talent matching EU ambitions; transition to new quality jobs also via adequate skills (**SFRs 2021, 2022**)

Why
