


Yield of a Dutch-German cross-visit







Agricultural innovation exchange between Lower Saxony and the Netherlands on sustainable soil management

The European Union promotes the dissemination of the knowledge developed through the European Innovation Partnership for Agriculture (EIP-Agri), including exchanges between the EU member states. The Dutch Network Support Units contributes to this, for example by supplying information on all the Dutch EIP projects (Operational Groups) to the European Commission and by stimulating exchanges with neighboring countries. For instance, the project leaders of Flemish Operational Groups are invited to our thematic meetings and we co-organized the organization of a cross-border meeting between the northern provinces and Lower Saxony.

The provinces of Groningen, Friesland and Drenthe, together with the EIP-Agri Network in Lower Saxony, took the initiative to exchange information about Operational Groups. For this purpose, a network meeting was organized on December 3rd 2019 at an experimental farm in the Netherlands. A total of 35 people were present. They were first given a tour on the farm (see picture).



Soil is the common theme

A comparison of the Operational Groups on both sides of the border showed that soil is the major common theme. So soil was chosen as the subject for the joint meeting. It covered soil fertility, soil health and nutrient- and water management. To give an impression of the projects, two examples were presented for each of these subjects; one from Lower Saxony and one from the Netherlands:

- Soil fertility: The Kompetenzzentrum Ökolandbau is conducting research into the use of
 compost in organic potato cultivation to increase soil fertility. In the Operational Group
 "Compost compositions" by HLB the use of enriched compost as soil improver is
 investigated.
- Soil health: the Gesellschaft für konservierende Bodenbearbeitung investigates weed control without the use of glyphosate and non-reversible soil tillage based on electrophysical, mechanical and biological methods. The Louis Bolk Institute is carrying out the project "Maize cultivation in permanent grassland, climate friendly and free from glyphosate".
- Nutrient- and water management: the Ostfalia Hochschule is developing a new way to
 measure plant drought stress with sensors. In the OG "Clean cultivation based on drip
 irrigation", Delphy examines whether minerals, (green) crop protection agents and bio
 stimulants can be supplied through an irrigation system.

What did the visit bring



Participants greatly appreciated the meeting. They made new contacts and exchanged knowledge about Operational Groups on both sides of the border. Ideas for new OGs were also developed, perhaps in the future with partners on both sides of the border. A concrete agreement was reached about a joint project that aims to organize "network activities" for farmers. To finance this, a joint INTERREG application will be developed.

The Agricultural Chamber Lower Saxony and the three northern Dutch provinces joined forces and indeed developed a proposal (and applied) about cross-border cooperation.

Due to personel change the topic was dropped. The application was retrieved and, partly b/c the COVID dynamics there unfortunetely hasn't been any follow up.

Take aways



- Interreg is perfectly equipped for cross border coorporation and may create a 'bridging project' involving OGs
- > The CAP 2023-2027 offers now new possibilities
- ➤ Ideas:
 - conduct an (GIS) analyses: distance actor-actor / possible theme for coorporation
 - Proactively invitre them to discuss synergy possibilities
