




For example: creating a common flyer



Partner 1: design



Common work: text and topic



Challenges



different languages and different working cultures

- clarify from the very beginning what is the common language and find somebody involved in the project who is able to translate if necessary
- calculate time and money for translation
- be well prepared about the working culture in the country of the partner and don't hesitate to ask for clarification

Challenges



different conditions and structures

- find out if the partner is at the same level of knowledge
- find out who is involved in the process/project of the partner and try to involve the equivalent person from your country
- clarify if the structure fits to each other



start with a common workshop and take your time to get to know each other



don't forget to calculate time for getting to know each other out of the workshop rooms;)

Challenges




different administrative rules and procedures

- be aware of different times for project calls, start together if possible, start with what you can do on your own for the project if not possible
- involve the administration from the very first beginning and clarify the rules (f.e. in Germany it is defined in the CAP SP that german project partners are able to accept the administrative rules from the lead partner)

Who is financing the first meeting





- be realistic: is the project possible with time lags due to different project calls?
- staff for project management?
- who is able to invest how much?
- who is going to be the Lead-Partner?
- what about the administrative rules and procedures?
