The SCAR SWG AKIS4 meeting in Bruxelles will be the second of the meetings proposed for the development of the mandate endorsed by the SCAR plenary in December 2015. This meeting will look to develop one particular cross-cutting topic identified in the mandate (1.D) "further development of the EIP approach" by exploring the future of "Advisory services" and the future of "Education" in the agricultural sector. Moreover, the IMPRESA project (www.impresa-project.eu) will be presented to the AKIS group in view of preparing jointly the last item of the mandate (Monitoring interactive innovation policies and benchmarking for sustainability).
