CAP post 2020 Communication "The future of food and farming"

- A modern CAP should support the strengthening of farm advisory services within the AKIS systems.
- This should become a condition for the approval of CAP Strategic Plans (which level in Germany? Region=Länder or MS level)
- ▶ The farm advice should remain voluntary for the farmer
- Specific obligations in the CAP AKIS plan to ensure results?
- Suggestions for a CAP AKIS toolbox:

creativity, new ideas, inspiration and cross-fertilisation.

Imagine some future characteristics enabling efficient AKISs.

Enhance knowledge flows within the AKIS and strengthen links between research and practice

- Establish practitioner networks (OG's)
- ► EIP Agri: Rural development and EU Research projects plus networks and innovation service providers as Innovation office, support unit etc.
- Association of Chamber of Agriculture with meetings on regular basis (education, advice, research)
- Cross border exchange: e.g. Cross visits, ERASMUS for farmers and advisors (transfer visits, field trips)or INTERREG EUROPE (cross border network activities)
- Create more (financial) incentives for advisors to play an important role as facilitator, translator...

Strengthen farm advisory services within MS' AKISs

- Train the trainer (process support, coaching and mentoring of young advisors, digital skills...)
- cross regional and cross border knowledge exchange
- Funded Advisory service opportunities and structures needed
- There has to be an advisory innovation support unit after the project funding
- More advisory support in particular areas, addressing societal challenges (resource efficiency, climate protection, socio-economic fields
- Avoid funding gaps between 2020 and 2021, continuity is important
- Trust is needed (longterm)
- Foster education for people working in agriculture, horticulture, forestry, fisheries as well as for advisors / multipliers

Incentivize interactive innovation projects

- ▶ Innovation support units close to farmers in a very early stage, to enable new cooperation, to ensure continuity of innovation networks and knowledge exchange about the innovation and the innovation process.
- Seed money to start an operational group, specially if there is no powerful background organisation involved
- Provide funding for field trips, cross-visits (ERASMUS Agrar) for project ideas in supra-regional EIP Networks
- Cross visits to focal topics e.g. Digitization

Support digital transition in agriculture

- Field events, peer to peer learning
- Workshops, conferences
- Bottom-up participation in developing digital tools according to the needs of the farmer
- Education, training and advice to speed up the use of already existing digital solutions

Framework in Germany

- Rural Development Policy 2014-2020
 - Partnership Agreement EC-MS (ESI funds)
 - 1 National Framework (GAK)
 - 13 regional rural development programmes
 - 9 regions implemented Knowledge transfer and information measure (M1)
 - 8 regions implemented funding for advisory services (M2)
 - ▶ 12 regions implemented EIP measure Cooperation (M 16)
 - National Rural Network = DVS and regional networks
