

## Networking for Innovation after 2020 What is new?



New CAP Cross-Cutting Objective Need to intensify networking activities fostering and sharing knowledge, innovation and digitalisation in agriculture and rural areas

Single CAP Network Scope: Pillar I + Pillar II
Streamlining and simplification without losing specialisation

More subsidiarity for MS Increased need for peer to peer exchanges, sharing of good practices, and stakeholder involvement
