1. Ambition of this study

- Assessing the extend to which MSs bridge the gap between research and practice :
 - <u>the linkages between research and practice</u> for the improvement of the AKISs CAP 2021-2027
 - the <u>integrated approach within the AKISs</u> and implementation of the EIP-Agri (focus on Advisors)
 - Challenges and future changes in relation to Horizon Europe and the interlinkages with CAP policy

2. Areas of investigation_(a)

- AKIS settings in the MSs
 - > Actors
 - Modalities & quality of interactions & knowledge flows
 - Types of incentives/tools for enhancing AKIS interlinkages
 - > Impartial advisory services

2. Areas of investigation_(b)

- >Approaches to strategic development of AKIS (CAP Strategic Plans)
 - >Structural & Functional analyses: who play which function and with whom?
 - ➤ (Co)-Development **common visions** on AKIS
 - Support to active participation and well-functioning of the AKIS
 - ➤ Enhancing knowledge flows
 - ➤ M&E arrangements to assess performance and support knowledge flows
 - >Organising the delivery and integration of advisory services
 - ➤Innovation Support Services
 - > Roles of AKIS coordination bodies

2. Areas of investigation (c)

- > Improving the integrated approach within the AKISs and for the EIP-Agri
 - > Approaches/methods to **strengthen knowledge exchange** between AKIS actors (up&down the R&I chain)
 - Practices to assess the needs of farmers and of advisors
 - Mechanisms/incentives in place to foster active participation
 - Bottlenecks/Solutions on interactions between key actors and processes
 - Connectors of OGs and Horizon MA Projects: role of the CAP networks, AKIS coordination bodies and others
 - Practices to help the synergies and complementarities among the different tools of the EIP-Agri at territorial level towards innovation

2. Areas of investigation_(d)

- > Challenges of Horizon Europe and its interlinkages with the CAP policy
 - Effectiveness of H2020 MA projects to **strengthen the linkages** between Research & Practice at local level
 - Effective development/mechanisms of synergies between H2020 and national funding
 - Mechanisms which allow the consistent participation of the end-users in H2020 projects
 - Organization of the linkages between NRN's and NCPs and other H2020 multipliers
 - Administrative burdens of H2020 to better link research and practice

3. Approach and Methods


PARTICIPATORY, DEVELOPMENTAL, INCLUSIVE

- ▶ 1- On line survey in 20 MS
- ▶ 2-Case studies and interactive sessions in 8 MSs: Belgium/Flanders, Bulgaria, Croatia, The Netherlands, Finland, Hungary, Italy, Spain.
- ▶ **3-Virtual interactive sessions**: <u>6 regional clusters:</u> Eastern EU, Mediterranean, Central and Nordic countries.
- 4-Desk research analysis: assessing the existing information on AKIS in the EU

4. Expected Outputs & Results

- Overview of the AKISs' and knowledge flows
- Collection of good practices on incentives/tools for knowledge flows and needs' assessment on of end-users (farmers, advisors etc);
- ▶ Identification of **bottlenecks** and **solutions** on interactions
- Methodology guidance for AKIS strategic co-planning in MSs
- Major awareness and common understanding of the MSs on the AKIS concept
- Collection of approaches for AKIS planning, monitoring and assessing for the future CAP
- Recommendations for a major connection of the AKISs & CAP with Horizon Europe
- Recommendations to contribute to improve impact of R&I
