DATA COLLECTION ON PRECISION FARMING

- Aim of the project: provide data on <u>uptake of precision farming techniques</u> across the EU farming community through public surveys
- Partnership:
 - <u>European Environment Agency</u> (EEA) started the project and financed a contract to
 Wageningen Environmental Research to design the farmers survey
 - <u>European Commission</u>: DG Agriculture (units C3 D2), DG Environment, DG Climate action,
 JRC (Ispra and Sevilla), Eurostat
 - the European farmers' association <u>Copa-Cogeca</u>,
 - the European agricultural machinery association CEMA,
 - the European Organization of Agricultural, Rural and Forestry Contractors <u>CEETTAR</u>
- Role of the partners: <u>design</u> <u>test</u> <u>promote</u> <u>analyze</u> the surveys









THE SURVEYS

The four surveys:

- A <u>survey to farmers</u> has been launched and has ended (1700 replies)
- A <u>survey for the machinery sector</u> has been launched and has ended (24 replies covering a big market share)
- A <u>survey to contractors</u> (services for farmers) is ongoing.
- A <u>survey to public administrations</u> (Rural development Managing authorities, paying agencies and advisers) is ongoing.

Time span:

- First concept note prepared beginning 2018
- Finalize analysis and results by the end of 2019

THE SURVEY FOR PUBLIC ADMINISTRATIONS - ADVISORS

Aim: get the "system" component

- RD interventions to training, advice, investments, cooperation activities in precision farming
- Role of paying agencies to provide data and information
- Role of advisors to promote precision farming in the farmers community
- Development of IT systems at regional local level (e.g. for integrated production)
- Integration in the digitization strategy at MS level

Promotion of the survey...

- Get a sufficient number of replies in order to <u>obtain representative results</u>
- The survey has been advertised to:
 - RD managing authorities and paying agencies
 - EIP and ENRD newsletter/initiatives (as done already for farmers survey)
- Spread the news to Farm Advisory Services / AKIS bodies
