### **Ideas to strengthen the Swedish AKIS**

- Increased funding for basic and applied research concerning the food chain
- Increase cooperation between
  research and practice national and international contacts and exchanges, conferences, peer-to-peer, think-tanks



- Strengthen the **networks for innovation** within the agricultural sector as well as with other businesses
- Better access for "rural actors" to national and ERUF resources for innovation and business advice

### Ideas to strengthen the Swedish AKIS

- Continued and developed support functions for collecting, processing and exchanging knowledge
- Establishment of a new knowledge center for at least animal husbandry (???)
- Substantially developed **advisory service** in certain fields

- Promote knowledge intensive cooperation concerning actions for biological diversity and water on a larger scale than farm size
- Farmer-to-farmer exchange, on-farm demonstration, study-trips etc
- Increased use of **digital solutions** for developing and spreading knowledge





### Challenges for knowledge exchange activities

- 1. Too much focus on structures instead of what actions drive the crucial processes
- 2. High belief in the society for top-down knowledge distribution instead of the need for more holistic iterative processes to find multifunctional solutions
- 3. Researchers dont merit of applied research and reality checks
- 4. Possible levels of funding and complexity within and outside CAP
- 5. Lack of energy for long run development among older farmers (33%), land leasers (ca 50%), and hard working farmers (99%...)
- 6. Common use of digital solutions and data bases

### Possible knowledge exchange activities in the CAP AKIS plan of Sweden

- 1. Substantial support functions where knowledge, experiences and inspiration can be collected, processed and exchanged among all AKIS actors, arenas for networking, group activities etc *if possible*
- 2. Vouchers for advice in certain fields of common interest
- 3. Farm-demo, field experiments, study-trips *if possible*
- 4. Exchanges between actors
- 5. Functions for cooperation in certain geografical areas for environment, water management etc *if no national finances*!
- 6. EIP-Agri
